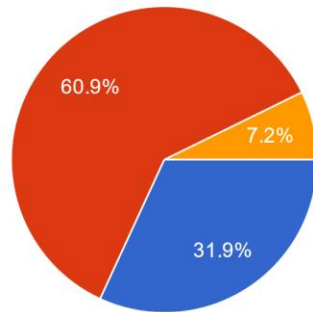

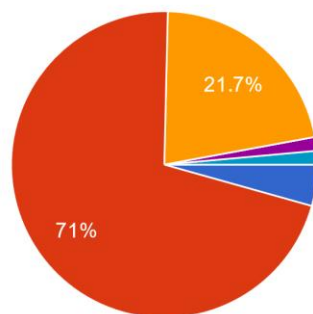

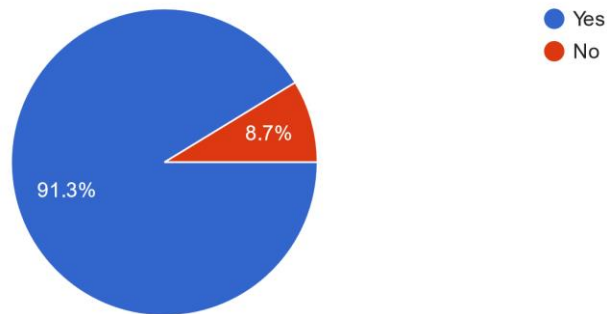

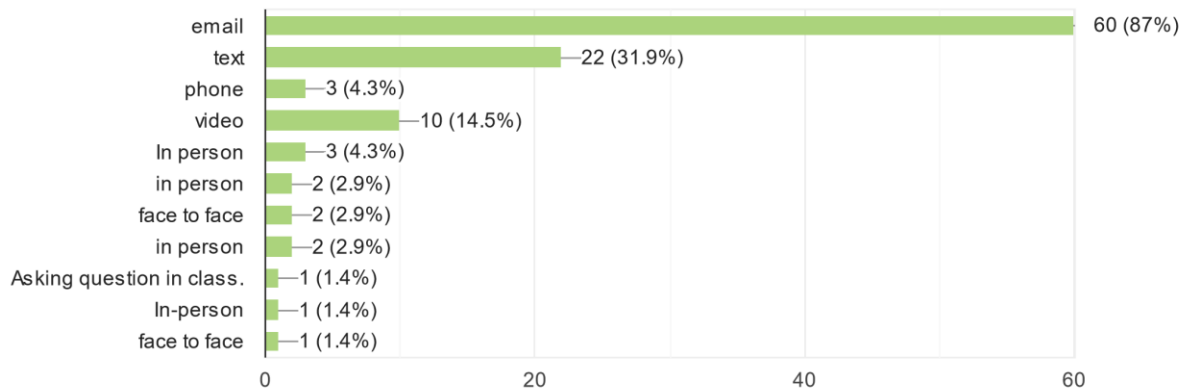


Do you feel you have sufficient contact with your instructor?

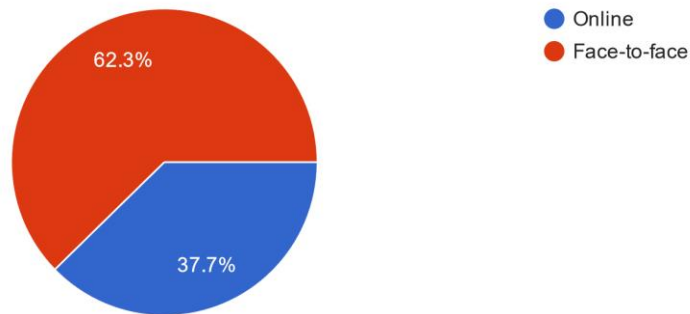


How do you prefer to communicate with your instructor? (Mark all that apply)

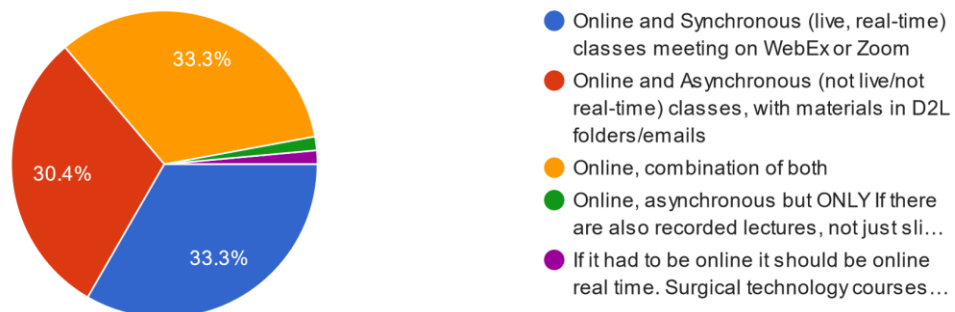


Overall, what is your preference for course delivery?

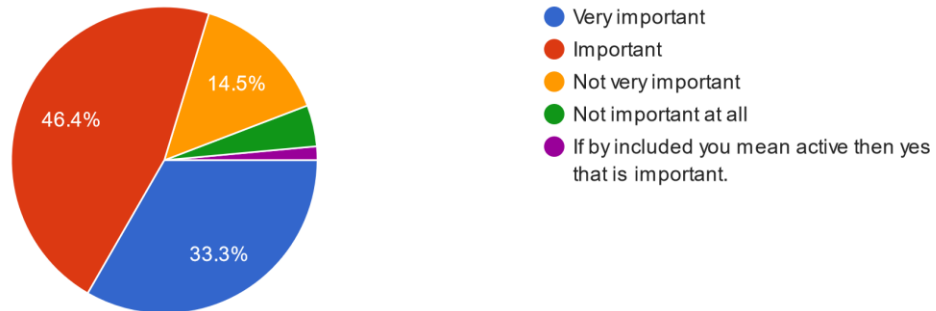


For online courses, which do you prefer?
