

# How to Post to the 400 Words Website

Go to [cte.openlcc.net/400-words](https://cte.openlcc.net/400-words) and read essays other faculty have written to get inspiration! You can browse all essays or browse by semester and discipline.

## Prepare to Add Your Essay

Type your story up in a word processor so you'll be able to copy and paste it into the editing area on the website. Give your essay a "byline" telling readers who you are. It helps to use boldface to set your byline apart from the rest of the text.



Create a title for your essay.

Optional – Prepare a header image (at least 1440px wide and <157 Mb). You'll need to provide attribution credit and [alternative text](#) for your image to make it accessible to those who are blind or have low vision. Use a photograph you took or find images that are free to use from one of the websites on the [Find Images webpage](#).

## Add Your Essay

1. When you are ready to post, click on [Add Your Essay](#)
2. Enter the access code – TLTT (you must use capital letters)
3. Enter your content. You must save first and preview once before it goes into the system as a draft. After that, continue to edit, save, and preview as much as needed.
4. Click **Publish Now** when you are ready for your work to be published. If you include your email address, you will be sent a link that will allow you to make changes later. Otherwise, you should finish your writing and publish it immediately.
